**Notes**

1. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying us at the address below.
2. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that we reclaim on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give).
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that we reclaim, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1).
4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask us, or ask your local tax office for leaflet IR 113 *Gift Aid*.

In the 2007 Budget, the Government announced that the basic rate of income tax would be reduced from 22% to 20% from April 2008.

As Gift Aid is linked to this basic rate, the amount of tax we would have been able to reclaim on any eligible donations would also have reduced. However in the 2008 Budget the Chancellor announced that to avoid loss of benefit to charities, Gift Aid levels would remain the same, meaning we can still claim the previous ratio of **28p in every £1**.

You can help us to maximise your donation at no extra cost to you, by making a Gift Aid declaration on all your donations to the charity. Simply complete the declaration form overleaf and return it to us whenever you make a donation. Every penny is appreciated and valued and helps us make a difference. Every penny donated through us will benefit the community of Bransgore. Every completed form makes it all worth that bit more.

Please remember that in order to reclaim Gift Aid, the amount you pay in income tax or capital gains tax must at least equal the amount we will claim during the tax year. Higher rate taxpayers may be able to claim further relief through the Self Assessment tax return.
